### Summary

Over have two recreation grounds – the village green and the community centre. There are a total of two cricket pitches, two senior and one junior football pitches and a MUGA marked for tennis, football and hockey.

The facilities at the community centre are excellent and attract users from neighbouring villages; the synthetic turf pitch at the community centre has flood lighting and can be used for 5-a-side football, tennis, touch rugby and hockey.

Drainage of the recreation ground was carried out in 2008 to improve pitch quality at a cost of £28430

A new all-weather surface was provided in 2008 to increase participation on the MUGA at a total project cost of £48712
