# Don't

Let your dog run up to a child unsupervised

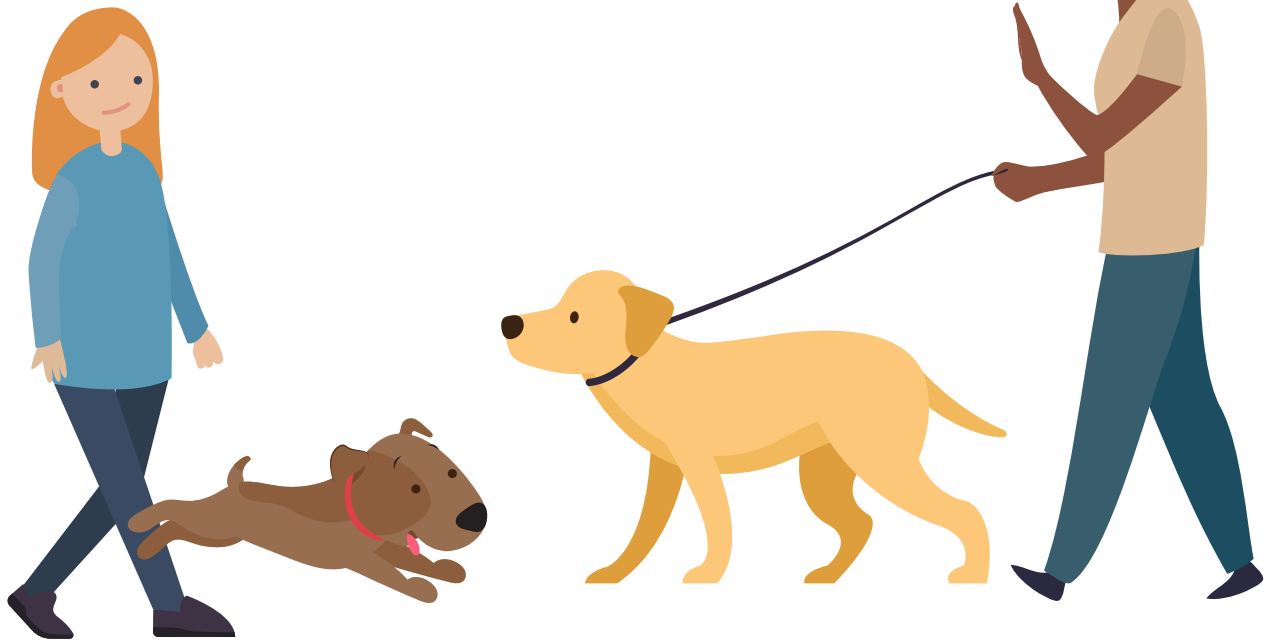


# Do

Listen and look out for warnings from owners about their dog



Can you put your dog on a lead please



# Don't

Let your dog off the lead if you can't easily recall them

I'm ignoring your whistle and doing my own thing!



# Dogs need manners



## Do

Give dogs time out or call them back when they play too rough

## Don't

Let your dog run up to dogs who are clearly scared



# Do

Look for signs on a dog's coat or lead to see if they are an assistant or service dog. These animals are working and need to concentrate



# Don't

Pet assistant or service dogs or allow your dog to approach them when they are working

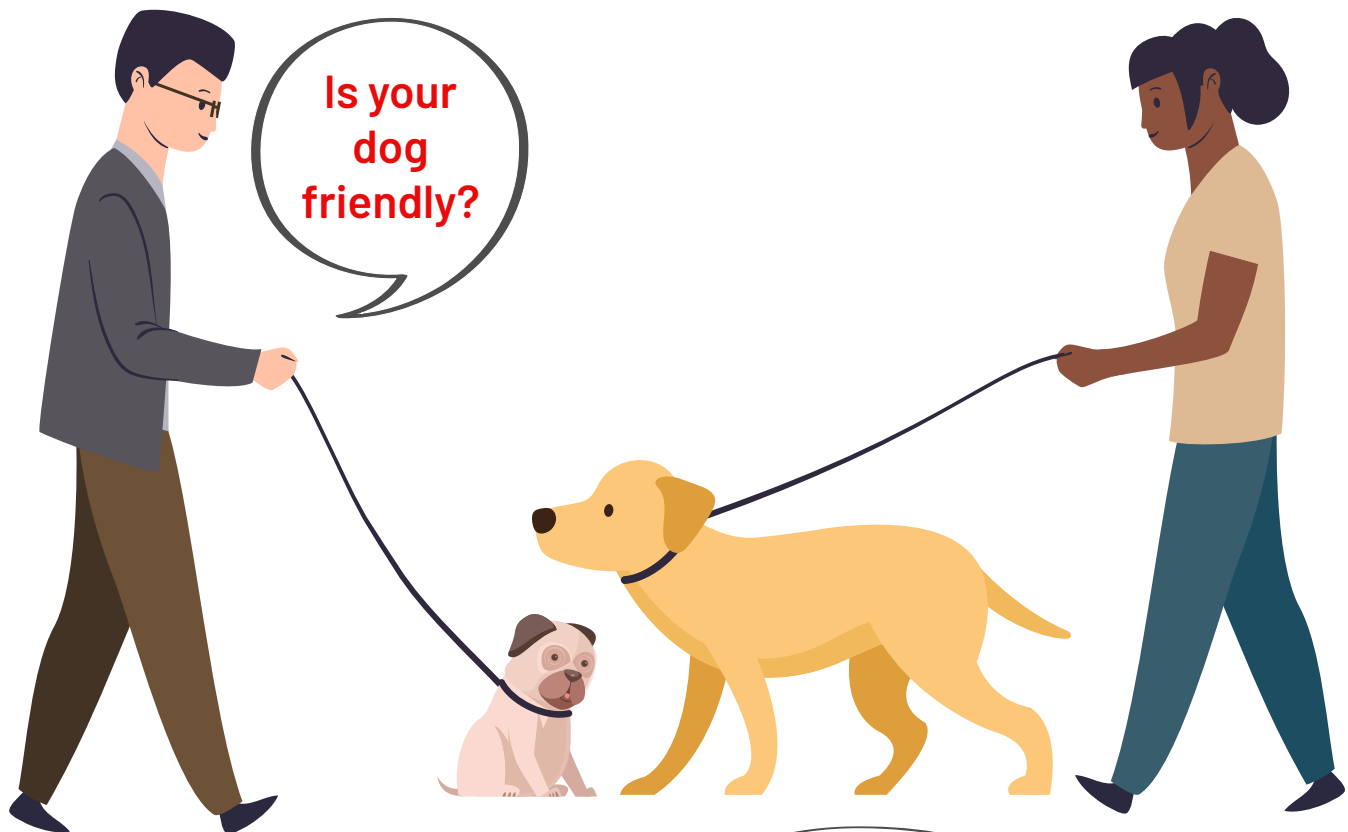

# Your dog may be friendly and happy to interact with others but not all dogs are



Some are anxious, aggressive, reactive, recovering from surgery or a new rescue dog. They may be in-season, elderly, frail or in training. For some dogs meeting lead to lead can make them aggressive.



# Do

Consider the dog and let them come to you



# Don't

Assume all dogs enjoy being petted
